

## Contraindications for HBOT

In the case of some medical conditions or if you are taking certain medication, we can advise you, for your own safety, against using the chamber or even forbid you from entering it!

When the use of a hyperbaric chamber is not allowed (absolute contraindications):

- Doxorubicin hydrochloride (Adriamycin) (a chemo-therapeutic drug)
- Bleomycin (a polypeptide antibiotic with a strong history of anti-tumor activity)
- Cis-platinum (a chemotherapy agent useful in as variety of cancers)
- Disulfiram (Antabuse) (an anti-convulsive agent)
- Mafenide Acetate (Sulfamylon) (an anti-bacterial drug that is frequently used in burns)
- Pneumothorax (untreated)

HBOT is one of the safest, least invasive and most benign in its side-effects of all modalities employed by hospitals and clinics. It is the author's opinion that, after medical screening, HBOT can be administered in the patient's home for a variety of conditions resulting in improved health and even resolution of many conditions.
